Frank Faulk specializes in technical security, focusing primarily in forensic computer analysis, technical surveillance counter measures (TSCM), and covert video applications. Mr. Faulk is adroit in covert surveillance techniques and hardware assembly, making him an ideal candidate to support both law enforcement agencies and specific needs of clients in the private sector. He has designed and implemented a large-scale, remote digital video recording system that is utilized by various agencies to record electronic intelligence and facilitate simultaneous investigations.

Mr. Faulk has worked for numerous companies at the management level of security, including Internet Service Providers, communication facility providers, and electrical automation engineering companies since 1990. Prior to period, Mr. Faulk ran a licensed alarm company, serving the San Fernando Valley and the Greater Los Angeles area.
